The end of the Millennial Kingdom

The Great Day of Yahuah

The final completion of the plan of Yahuah will be in the great harvest of all people who lived in the planet earth, Revelation 20:5, and this will be the final Decree, the Great Day of Yahuah, Revelation 20:11-15, also known as the White Throne Judgement. Scriptures reveal the truth*

Opening with Satan released

Revelation 20:7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison.

Comment: We know from Scripture that a messenger threw Satan in the bottomless pit and bound him with chains. Some try to explain that this "pit" was planet earth and this was the place Satan walked around alone for almost 1000 years.

The problem with this explanation is that there were nations and the habitants were like the sand of the sea, impossible to be counted, so, where did these people come from? One point to mention is that Satan was bound with chains so he could not deceive the nations of the earth for 1000 years.

Revelation 20:8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

Comment: Oops! There it is! Some teachers erroneously say that Satan will be on earth during the millennium alone and with nobody to talk to or hurt. But who are these nations with populations in the billions? Can they rapidly multiply to billions?

Revelation 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the Set Apart camp, and the beloved city: and fire came down from Elohim out of heaven, and devoured them.

Comment: Some say this is the New Yerushalom that came down from heaven, but this event is sequentially mentioned later on. We can read in Scripture exactly what and where this Camp and beloved city really are! Zechariah 14:4 And His feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Yerushalom on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley;

and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

This is the huge valley where the camp is located! It is <u>ONLY</u> my opinion that the habitants of this Camp could be the 144000 (<u>THIS HAS NOTHING TO</u> <u>DO WITH THE "JEHOVAH WITTNESSES SECT"</u>)Revelation 14:1 And I looked and looked a

looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Zion, (Mount of Olives reaches a height of 765 meters above sea level and at its summit, according to popular tradition lies the grave of King David. In the Byzantine Period this western hill of Jerusalem began to be called by the name of Mount Zion) and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having the Father's name written in their foreheads.

We know the beloved City is Yerushalom, where Yahusha the Messiah and His cabinet would be located, nothing less than the throne of David.

Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Comment: Now we have the leader, that old serpent, going to a place of no return and will be destroyed and left for nothing just like his best friends, the beast, the false prophet and demons.

For ever and ever is a Hebrew idiomatic expression and it does not mean eternity, it means until the end of a matter, for example, I promised my wife to love her for ever and ever, obviously the marriage will last until one of us dies, well, get the picture?

Revelation 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 12And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Yahuah; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.13And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Comment: This is at the end of the millennium, there will be a second resurrection of the mortals that lived and died during this period. And here all will stand before Yahuah to be judged.

Revelation 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and Him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Comment: This will be the final Decree, the Great Day of Yahuah, Revelation 20:11-15, known as the White Throne Judgement.

O.J Simpson had a look on his face throughout the trial, standing in the presence of "human justice". I cannot even begin to comprehend what it will be to be in the presence of the Almighty, The Creator of the Universe.

Revelation 20:14-15 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Comment: This may be difficult to swallow for some, but clearly, the just and the wicked will resurrect and a book with names will be opened, the righteous, the ones who thru the millennium learnt the truth and accepted the Messiah will be granted eternal life, the wicked will not be found written here and will be thrown to the lake of fire. I can almost tell you that Hitler will be in this Court room.

1 Corinthians 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued unto Him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto Him that put all things under Him, that Yahuah may be all in all.

Comment: The Messiah ruled the nations with a rod of iron and straightened out all matters and turns the Kingdom over to The Father. This is beautiful!

Revelation 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. 2 And I John saw the Set Apart city, the new Yerushalom, coming down from Yahuah out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Comment: And now is when the NEW YERUSHALOM comes down prepared as a bride, with gold, silver and precious stones. We must know Hebrew

customs to deeply understand what this means, a Hebrew woman collects jewelry since childhood to be adorned for her husband the day of the wedding (look up Ezekiel 16:11, 23:40 and Jer 4:30).

Revelation 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the dwelling of Yahuah Elohim is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and Yahuah himself shall be with them, and be their Mighty One. 4 And Yahuah shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. 5And He that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And He said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. 6And He said unto me, It is done. I am Aleph and Tah, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Comment: Remember what Yahusha said? Your Kingdom come!... He did not say take us to heaven! Now the communion Adam and Eve had with the Creator of the Universe is restored to all who found eternal life. This will be eternity as Yahuah restores all things as they were meant to be at the beginning. This time the enemy of man kind will not appear again.

Revelation 22:1-5 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of Elohim and of the Lamb. 2In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. 3And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of Yahuah and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: 4And they shall see His face; and His Name shall be in their foreheads. 5And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for Yahuah Elohim giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.
