## 1 atatime.org *Reflections*

In the year 2005, I came to realize that the Mashiach has a Hebrew Name. Most of humanity does not know Him at all. Because of iniquity, traditions and erroneous translations He is now called by a pagan Latin/Greek title and name: "*Iesus*", "*Jesus*" and "*Christ*". There are thousands of languages in the world, by result; people call Him in thousands of different ways. Since He is *ONLY* the Mashiach of Ysrael, He MUST have a Hebrew Name; Yahusha,  $\circ \lor \uparrow ?$  a contraction of the combination of "Yahuah" and "HuSha. In Hebrew, Yahusha means "Yahuah is Salvation," because He is the source, the word (*the Aleph and the Tah*) Yahuah gave men to be saved. With great joy I accept the name revealed by our Heavenly Father for the Redeemer: Yahusha.



Yochanan 5:43 <u>I am come in My Father's name</u>, and ye receive me not: <u>if another shall come in his own name</u>, him ye will receive.

• W 1 1 1 Yahusha, 78, the Aleph and the Tah, the first and last letters of the **Hebrew Alphabet.** He is the KING of YSRAEL. The Hebrew idea conveyed in the title "Mashiach" certainly means the "anointed" one, and only one can have this title — the KING. The Greek word "*CHRIST*" was used as a title for several Pagan deities.

While studying the true Name, remember: Yahusha  $\circ \vee \lor \lor \lor \lor$  was not a <u>Christian</u>, and His Name isn't <u>based</u> on Greek, but <u>Hebrew</u>. "HESUS" is a Hebrew term, meaning "the horse. Names do not change, Julio Iglesias, George Bush, or Michael Gorvachov are the same in any country.

The <u>true</u> Name of the Mashiach can be proven by deduction; and we should know that we cannot trust the Greek to explain the Hebrew. But, when we see that the Greek text uses the same letters (IESOUS) when referring to the men that translators spell as "Joshua" and "Jesus", then we know these letters refer to not just a *similar* name, but the <u>same</u> name; the Greek alphabet simply corrupted the Name for us.

In *Hebrews chapter 4* and *Acts chapter 7* (Hebrews written by Sha'ul, and Acts by Luke), we discover from the Greek that the Savior's Name is spelled IESOUS. I'm not saying these two men wrote the text in Greek, but the Greek is what we have received. The name "JESUS" isn't even in the original Scriptures - and you can check out the way it looked back in 1599 by clicking on this: 1599 Geneva Translation.

## JESUS OR ○ W Y # ? YAHUSHA?

**Both cannot be correct.** Since there was no letter "J" on planet Earth until around 1530 CE, one of these two is already exposed. To say "we speak English" isn't a defense of anything, since the "only Name" given in which there is salvation is a Hebrew Name, not an English one (Acts 4:12). The letters used to convey the correct sound of the Name to call upon <u>are</u> in English. Neither of the two originated in English. Yahuah does not change, so the Name of our Meshiach would not undergo alterations over time, unless another being tampered with it- such as an enemy! We know we must overcome the deceptions, and a very serious "stronghold" is His false name, which the anti- Mashiach will use to deceive the nations.

Page after page could be written about the Name of our Savior, however, there must be an attitude of receiving the truth to comprehend how important it is to know "who" we are calling upon.
